

DANIEL FAST INSTRUCTIONS

To God be the praise! We are now embarking on a New Year ~~year~~ with hopes and expectations of overwhelming success and bountiful blessing. As in prior years of being led by the Lord to summon his people that we may fast and pray seeking godly direction as we endeavor to execute God's will.

It is my sincere desire that as a ministry called to witness Christ in the last days that we endeavor to become true disciples. As we collectively fast and pray, let us seek a great outpouring of God's spirit on our ministry, our families and our friends. I encourage each of you to sincerely pray that God's will be accomplished in the lives of his people.

Instructions for the Daniel fast:

- There will be no fasting Sundays.
- The fast will begin on January 11, 2012 and conclude on February 3, 2012.
- Anoint your head, hands and feet each day. Asking the Lord to guide your thought process, multiply what comes into your hands, and order your steps.

Scripture reading for the duration of the fast is - **Psalms 1: 1-6.**

- We will pray three times a day, morning, noon and night. Repeat the Lord's Prayer found in Matthew 6: 9-13.

• Wednesday, January 11 - Saturday, January 14

We will begin the fast at 6:00 AM and conclude at 3:00 PM

• Monday January 16 - Saturday, January 21

We will begin the fast at 6:00 AM and conclude at 2:00 PM.

• Monday, January 23 - Saturday, January 28

We will begin the fast at 6:00 AM and conclude at 1:00 PM.

• Monday, January 30 - Friday, February 3

We will begin the fast at 6:00 AM and conclude at 12:00 noon.

This will be our final day of fasting, may the Lord bless you as you walk in obedience.

Please be mindful of a very important event, on the fourth Sunday in January at 4:00 PM I will License the Deacon and Deaconess for service unto the Lord. During this Spirit filled service there will be feet washing and baptism as we celebrate the goodness of God. Please invite your family members and friends to witness this great occasion.
